**Proposal 1 – Presidential and U.S. Representatives Term Amendments**

Changing the president to one 6-year term, and the US Reps form 2 to 4-year terms. The new terms of office that the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Amendments to the U.S. Constitution.

**Proposal 2 – Voting Day Reform – Access to the Polls**

**First**, the traditional first Tuesday voting date in November will be immediately and permanently moved to the first Saturday in November. **Secondly**, synchronizing the opening and closing of all polling places to the same 12 hour period. NO amendments required. Not rocket science!

### Proposal 3 – Eligible Voter Reform

We must confront the issue that those citizens convicted of felonies are not allowed to vote in national elections often for the rest of their life, to say nothing about state and local levels which is worse. This is not healing or building respect for government.

### Proposal 4 – Real Campaign Finance Reform

Real campaign finance reform is about the struggle to control the excessive and imbalanced influence of the Special Interest money that is pouring into national elections. The same can be said for the state election process, as well.

In a version of the *Merriam-Webster* International Dictionary the word ‘bribe’ is defined as follows:

a price, reward, gift, or favor bestowed or promised with a view to pervert the judgment or corrupt the conduct esp. of a person in a position of trust (*as a public official*).

The U.S. Supreme Court ruled before 2008 in opposition to funding controls or limits to big campaign donors. They can do so anonymously also! It was very Republican of them.

It could be observed as a ruling that honored “The Law” and completely ignored the Democratic Reason and *common sense*. I say the control and prevention of the abuse of political Power by the Few over the Many is exactly what the US Constitution is all about.

Our grassroots movement to replace Congress will be our “final answer” to campaign finance reform.

## **The Population Issue –**

A few key points about this Industry restructuring are listed, but you must review the full proposal to understand the overall reasoning and public benefits.

- The “Involuntary” restructuring and consolidation of all for-profit and non-profit Health insurance corporations.
- All existing Health insurance corporations will become operating Divisions under a new Health Insurance Consortium created for the restructuring and consolidation process.

- Existing Executives and Boards of Directors will be retired.
- Medical plans and premiums will be simplified.
- The costly and ridiculous annual re-enrollment in medical plans will be eliminated in no less than 24 months.
- All American citizens will be covered.

Remaining five (5) proposals will be considered for implementation by an informed American public.
